Ideal, Norm and Law

The inherent contradiction of the concept of ideal shows the gap between the imaginary and symbolic levels of ideals. In

the confrontation with the other/Other, there are two paths for the subject. One

path leads to a more symbolic ideal and law, the other path ends in an imaginary game of

norms. Considering Foucault's thesis about the historical transformation from a society

of sovereignty to a society of normativity,

norms are becoming more important.

Besides the logical analysis of the subject

positions, a dialectical understanding

provides an opportunity to understand the link between law and emancipation. This

understanding has implications for

psychoanalysis and its clinical applications.

#### The Effects of Psilocybin-Induced Ego-Dissolution in a Case of Gender Dysphoria: A Psychoanalytic Investigation

This article presents a clinical case study of a transgender individual engaged in psychoanalytic psychotherapy following two unguided psilocybin experiences in which they first experienced themselves as female. The paper seeks to address the question of how to think about and work with psychedelic imagery and transformations in selfhood and identity particularly around gender and sexuality. By comparing the psychedelic state to dreaming, I offer a tentative conceptualization of psychedelics as a transitional space in which unconscious and repressed affects that are central to one's particular form of psychic suffering can emerge into consciousness in order to be worked through.

#### Coming and going from the setting to the actuality

The construction of the setting in the session is determined by the analyst and his or her identity, by his or her analytic training and by the cultural moment in which he or she is inserted. From the disconnection in the session with a patient we can analyze different failures in the setting. The dialectic between having our own identity as psychoanalysts and at the same time being part of this society is actualized in each encounter with the patient. All this in the context of a world that has recently undergone a crisis that as psychoanalysts has forced us to make quick moves that only now, in a second time with more perspective, we can think about and integrate in an honest way as part of who we are.
