

## Brief CURRICULUM VITAE ET STUDIORUM by Salvatore Giannone

Salvatore Giannone is a psychologist, child/adolescent/family psychotherapist and psychoanalyst-in-training from Rome.

He completed his studies in “Developmental and Educational Psychology” at Sapienza University in Rome (bachelor 2018, master 2010). He had been a visiting student at “Eisenberg-Spinrad Lab” and “School of Social and Family Dynamics” at Arizona State University AZ (2009).

In 2016 he got a second Master of Art in “Infant Observation Studies – Working with children, young people and family: a psychoanalytic observational approach” (CSMH-Tavistock Clinic-University of East London) and in 2017 completed the clinical course with the training as a Psychotherapist (Tavistock model) in Florence, Italy. Finally, he is currently advanced candidate at the Psychoanalytic Training Institute of the Italian Psychoanalytical Society (SPI) in Rome (2020-2024).

For more than a decade he had been working in Institutional (“San Raffaele Roma” Institute for Treatment and Research - National Health Service – Ecclesiastical, Ordinary and Juvenile Courts – Education Programs) and private context with adults, adolescents, children and families.

In the period 2010-2015 he was Project Proposal Expert for a non-profit-organizations, being also Representative elected in the board of Lazio Region Office for the Volunteers association (2010-2012).

In the following 2017-2018 he worked as a psychotherapist at the Center for Motor Education (CEM) of the Italian Red Cross in Rome, with adults having physical and mental disabilities (and their families).

He holds a professional education course within the Educational Services (0-6) of the Lazio Region (2019) and within the Tuscan Educational Services (2023). These initiatives focused on raising awareness of early intervention strategies aimed at fostering children's relational well-being.

He is interested in early intervention in childhood, child protection, child-adult interaction, parental competence, primitive mental state in adults and children.

He carries on study and research on these topics in both his private and institutional practice in Rome. He is also active in promoting and disseminating psychoanalytical culture.

For IPSO he was an IPSO representative for his Training Institute in Rome, Italy 2022-2024. He supported the Visiting Candidate Programs (VCPs) in Rome where a German candidate was hosted

(2024). He was part of an organization committee in “IPSO Around the Word in a Day” (20.03.2021). He participated also to IPSO events in 35<sup>^</sup> EPF in Wien (2022), 36<sup>^</sup> EPF in Cannes (2023), 27<sup>^</sup> EPF in Florence (2024) as a co-chair and in the organization team for IPSO Party, 28<sup>^</sup> EPF in Dresden as a presenter (2025), 27<sup>°</sup> IPSO European Meeting in Berlin (2023), 28<sup>°</sup> IPSO European Meeting in Istanbul (2024) as a chair and he is currently involved in the organization of the next 29<sup>°</sup> IPSO European Meeting in Rome (2025).
